

Code of Behaviour for Parents/Guardians

As a parent/guardian of a participant in any activity held or attended by The Portland Gymnastics Club Inc. you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any such activity or event:

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others
- 2. Remember that your child participates in sport for their own enjoyment, not yours.
- 3. Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- 4. Never ridicule or yell at your child or other children for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 5. Show appreciation for good performance by all participants (including opposing participants).
- 6. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with, or in the vicinity of persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example.
- 7. Respect our coaches and officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- 8. Do not physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated with the sport (participant, coach, judge, another parent/guardian etc.).
- 9. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 10. Be a positive role model.
- 11. Allow fellow parents the respect they deserve in their viewing or involvement in their child's participation.
- 12. Parents/Guardians are not allowed on the floor whilst training or a competition is in progress.
- 13. Parents/Guardians are to approach coaches only at the start or end of the session. Meetings can be arranged in advance if a more extensive conversation is required.
- 14. Parents/Guardians are to ensure that if they have any other child/ren not participating in the session that they are kept off the gym floor and equipment.

- 15. Parents/Guardians are to ensure that if they or their child/ren have food that they eat during the session, it is done so whilst seated in the waiting area and all rubbish is placed in bins.
- 16. Parents/Guardians and/or Child/ren who breach this code of conduct may be subject to disciplinary actions that could include but is not limited to the following:
 - Verbal warning by coach or committee/staff member.
 - Written warning.
 - Parent/Guardian and Child/ren removal from premises.
 - Parent/Guardian and Child/ren term suspension
 - All Breaches will be recorded
